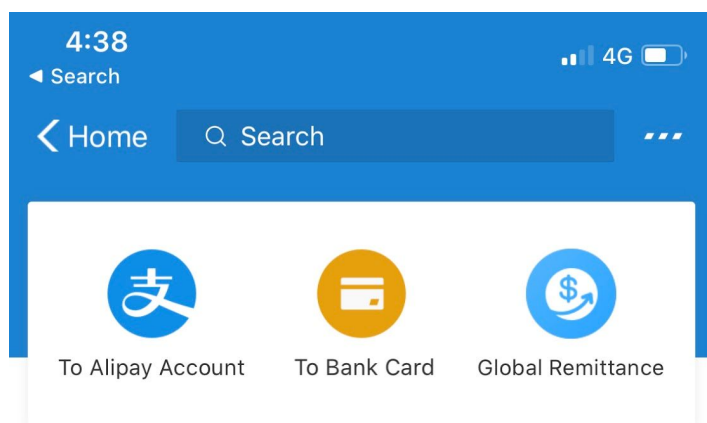

AliPay App Navigation Introduction

AliPay, or **支付宝** (Zhīfù Bǎo) in Mandarin Chinese, is already an essential part of daily life in big, modern Chinese cities. In 2019, AliPay added support for non-Chinese credit cards, meaning that more and more people could finally take part in the mobile payments revolution occurring in China.

Unfortunately, foreign credit card support did not mean a fully translated English version of the app. In fact, large sections of the app remain untranslated. Here's an example of a page from the iOS English language version of the app, only one tap (on "Transfer") away from the main screen:

AliPay Transfer How-To

支付宝账户转账到对方支付宝账户 的方法介绍

1. 打开支付宝点击“转账”按钮。
2. 选择“转到支付宝账号”。
3. 填写对方的支付宝账号。
4. 填写转账金额。
5. 同时也可以在备注里填写转账理由。
6. 点击“确认转账”按钮后输入密码。
7. 这样这次转账就成功了。

注意事项：

- 1、根据支付宝账户类型和转账形式的不同，单日的转账金额都有不同的**限额**。
- 2、支付宝账户的资金直接转到对方的支付宝账户以后，**无法退款**。
